The Venue

A unique getaway in a cutting-edge hotel with a modern design

Hotel Barceló Sants, in the centre of Barcelona, is very well connected.

It is very easy to arrive from the airport and from the AVE (fast trains to Madrid-Paris-Valencia).

Hotel Barceló Sants has an avant-garde and futuristic look that resembles a space station, where guests can imagine they're on an inter-galactic trip.


Located above Sants Railway Station and with direct access to the highspeed AVE and Barcelona's metro and local train links, this is the bestconnected hotel in the city. It's just 500 metres from Plaza Espanya and the scenic Montjuïc district, 15 minutes by train from Barcelona El Prat Airport and 4 minutes by train from Plaza Catalunya.

Public transport & taxi

Hotel Barceló Sants is located over the Barcelona-Sants train and metro station. Serviced by RENFE, Metro, AVE.

Barcelona-El Prat airport is 12 km away. There is a direct connection via train from the airport (T2) and a bus.

Alternatively, a taxi from the airport will cost around 30-35€.

Finding the Hotel

If you are coming from inside Barcelona-Sants train station follow the signs to **Plaça de Joan Peiró**. Exit the Barcelona-Sants train station. The entrance to the Hotel is 50m from the exit. Look for the **H** sign and then take the lift to the hotel reception.

Registration

Registration for MoodleMoot Global 2022 attendees will start on **Tuesday 27 September** from **08:30-09:00h**.

Registration will take place at the Helpdesk on the first floor.

Upon arrival at the venue, please proceed up the stairs or take the elevator to the first floor (**floor E**). All registered attendees will receive their name badges. For safety reasons, the badges must be worn at all times during the event.

A cloakroom will be available for attendees during the event.

Those staying at the hotel are encouraged to use the Hotel luggage room upon arrival and departure.







La Paloma, the oldest dance hall in Europe.

The history of Paloma dates back to 1903. Boleros, rumba, chachachá and disco animated the nights of La Paloma, in Raval, for more than a century.

Starting in 1999, it experienced a second splendid era in which it became a key point of musical miscegenation and the most select and hedonistic electronic music. This was abruptly cut short in 2006 due to its closure by municipal order.

In September 2022, La Paloma opens its doors to welcome the Moodle community.

Note: The party is a ~35 minutes walk or ~25 minutes by metro (L1) from the conference venue.

Covid-19 Advice

Since the travel restrictions for travellers coming to Spain may be changing, we strongly recommend you consult the latest travel information to enter Spain by visiting the following websites:

- Check the <u>Travel Safe Spain</u> website, which contains very useful information about travelling to Spain.


As per the current Catalan and Spanish Health authorities guidance, proof of double vaccination is not mandatory to attend the event. Masks are currently required on public transport in Barcelona, so please travel with a mask. **Health and safety for all participants is our main priority, so we encourage all participants to take a lateral flow (rapid) test before attending the event and to stay home if they are feeling unwell.** Please note, we are monitoring government guidance and will adapt our plans as necessary. Any major changes will be communicated via email and published on the event website, so we recommend you check this regularly.

You are encouraged to wear masks indoors; however, in line with current Spanish and local government health guidelines (April 2022) this is not obligatory and we respect your choices regarding mask wearing. For health and safety reasons, the Hotel may apply some additional measures adapted to the current situation. We are monitoring the <u>Catalan and Spanish government guidelines</u> and we will be updating the <u>website</u> accordingly.

If you test positive for Covid-19 before the event, you will need to <u>notify us in writing via</u> <u>our contact form</u> before midnight Sunday 25 September 2022 (UTC+2) and send us proof of a positive Covid-19 test. You will receive a refund, minus an administration fee of \in 50. No refunds will be given due to non-attendance or after this date. Once you complete the <u>contact form</u>, the MoodleMoot Global team will get back to you in due course to confirm the next steps.

If current Covid restrictions result in the cancellation of the live event, the event will be postponed or moved to an online format. All registrations from attendees will be automatically transferred to the new dates. If the event is rescheduled, it will be held within 12 months of the original conference dates. All attendees will be notified via email and given the option to receive a full refund. If the event cannot be rearranged within this timespan, all attendees will be given a full refund.
