

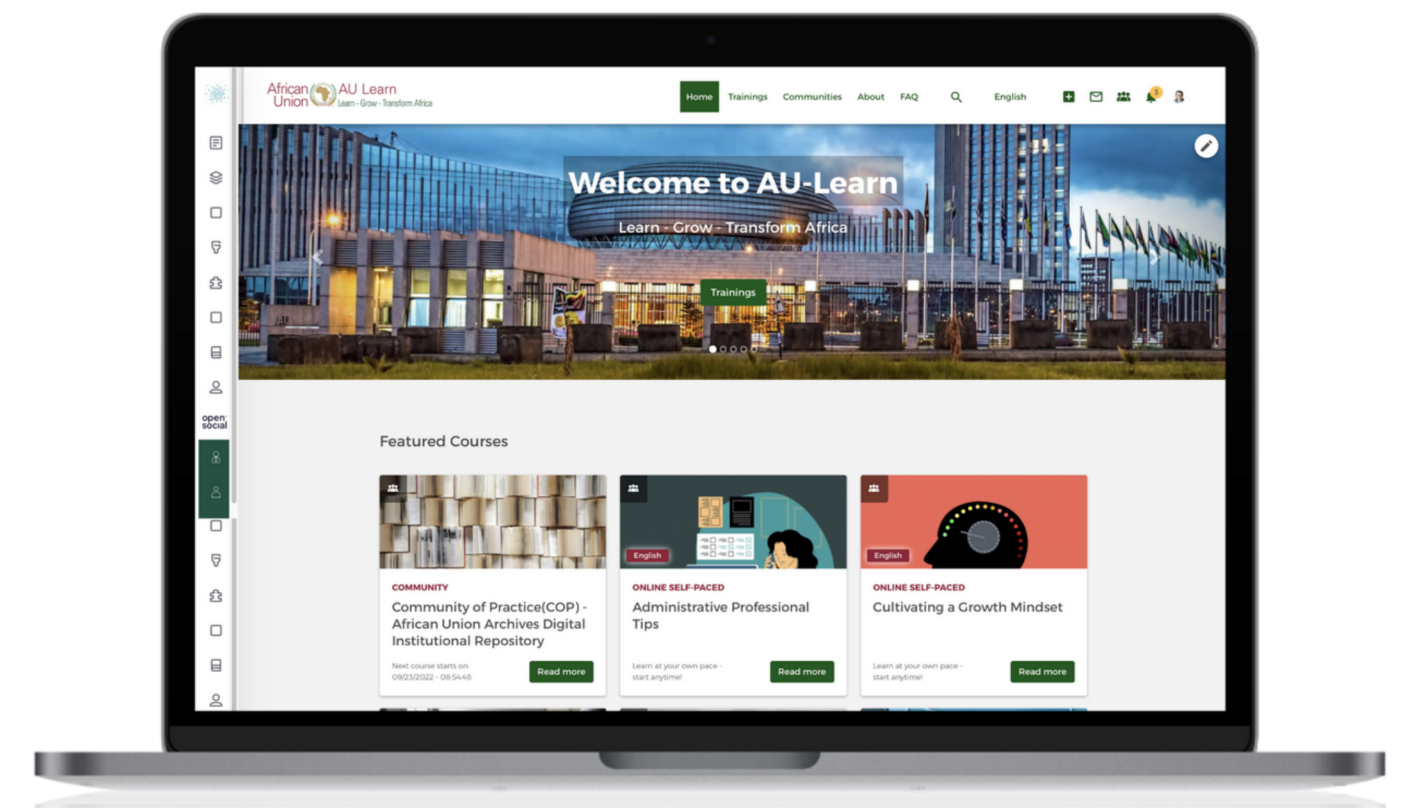

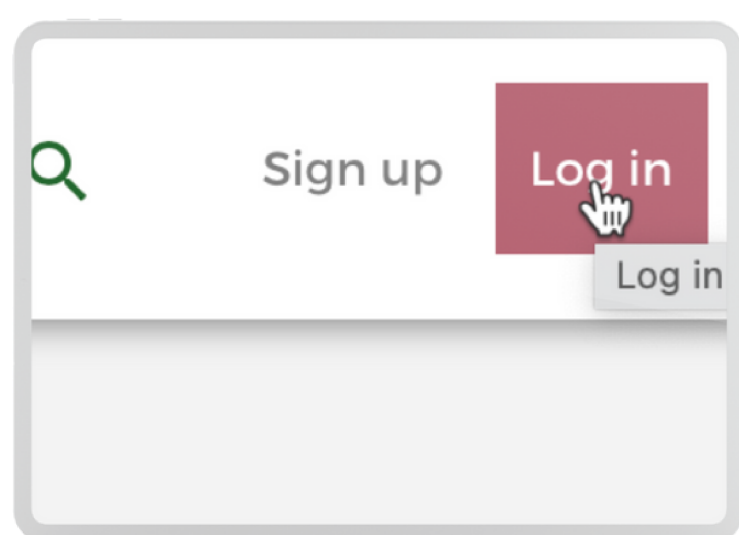


Use cases: Why to integrate Moodle and Drupal

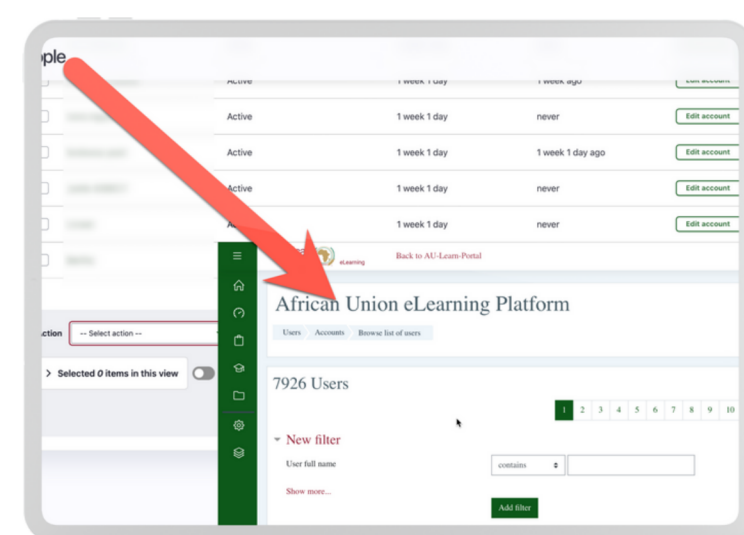
- **Seamless:** Integrate the LMS with website/CMS/portal solutions
- **Flexible:** Make use of CMS functionalities to create your learning portal (e.g. landing pages, content outside of courses)
- **Enhanced:** Blend community and library solutions with LMS
- **Standardised:** Advanced course creation and course life cycle
- **Automated:** Advanced course registration/enrolment processes
- **Informed:** Sophisticated reporting structures, based on your KPIs



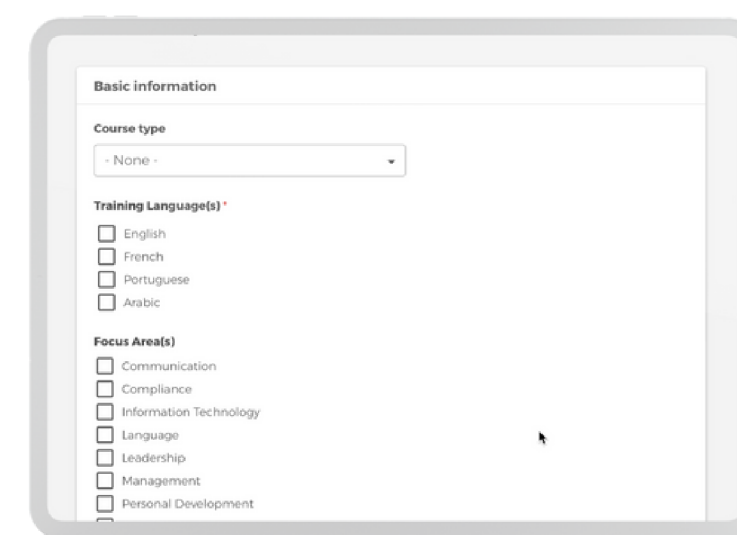
Features: Advantages of the Moodle & Drupal Integration



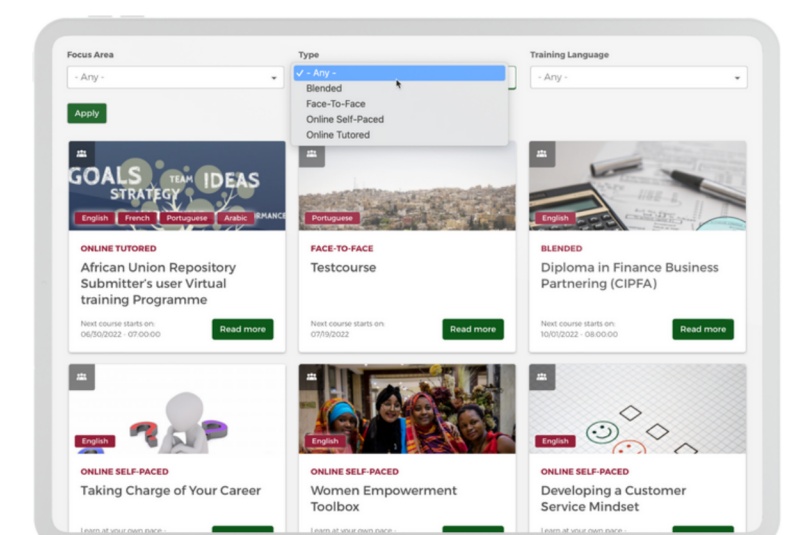
SSO between Moodle and Drupal - seamless navigation between the two applications



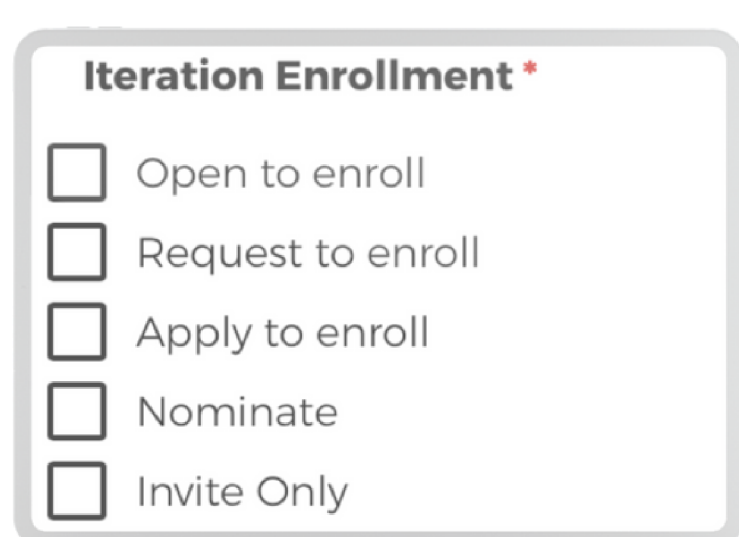
Automatic account creation and synchronisation between Moodle and Drupal



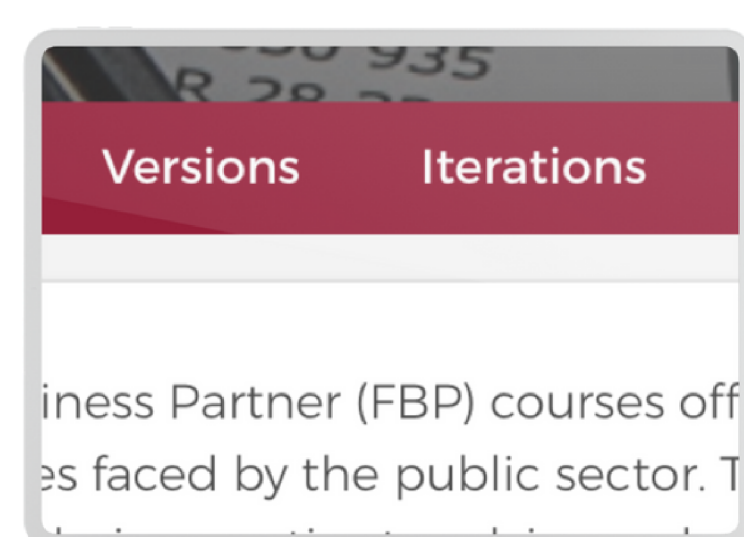
Custom course creation forms providing just the right options needed for the organisation



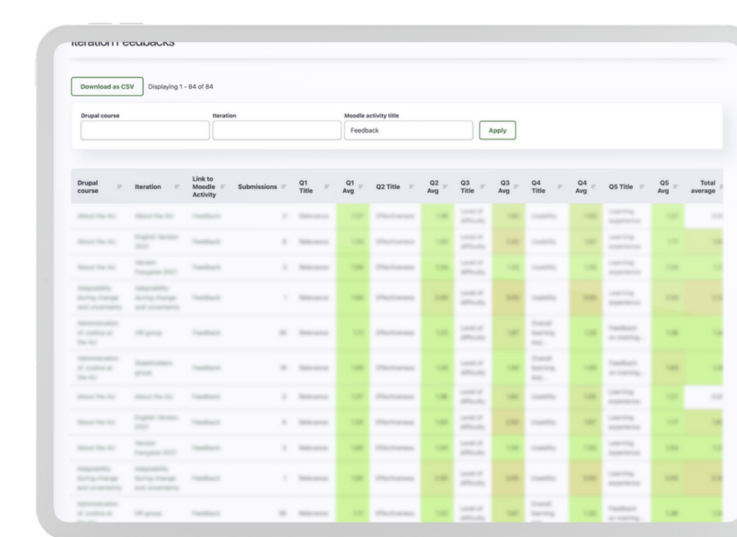
Maintaining a sophisticated course catalogue structure, bundling Moodle courses that belong together



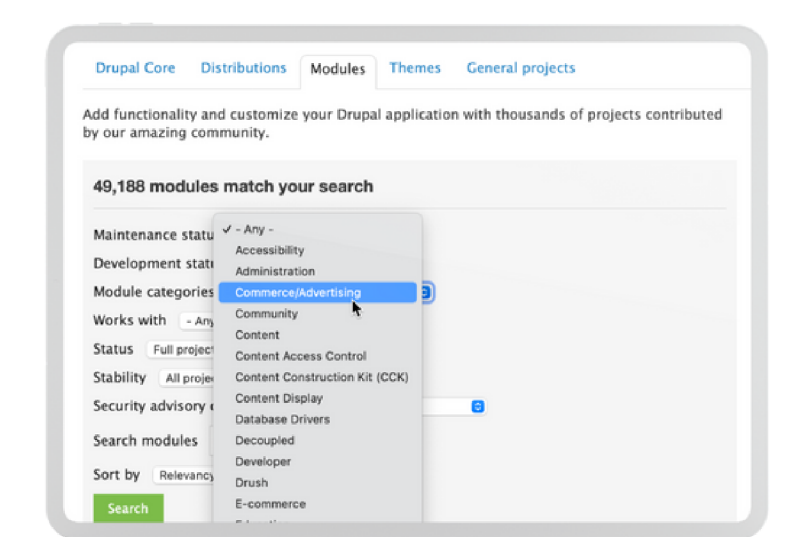
Building custom enrolment processes, including individual multistep and/or supervisor approval etc.

Outlook: The sky is the limit

- Improve the usability of our Moodle & Drupal combination
- Publish our module on Drupal.org and Moodle.org
- Enhance data retrieval on Drupal, for creating sophisticated views and dashboards
- Develop a full Moodle-Drupal integrator module that blends the course working space fully inside of a Drupal portal solution
- Create a fully fledged decoupled app that supports the full solution package
- Support for multi-tenancy architecture: e.g. one central Drupal portal with multiple Moodle installations behind (e.g. supporting all schools of a region etc.)
